
THE LIFE CYCLE OF A STAG BEETLE

TAKES 3 TO 4 YEARS

Breeding season (1-3) - late May until the beginning of August

Eggs (4) - several batches of a few eggs each laid in the soil near decomposing wood Larval development (5-8) - in regions with mild winters, 2 years feeding on decomposing wood; perhaps longer elsewhere

Pupa (9) – a few weeks in the summer inside a compacted soil ball deep into the ground **Adult stag beetle** (10) – fully formed by the beginning of September but waits underground until next year to fly outside
